


Liverpool University Press

- Founded 1899 and restructured in 2004
- ▶ A wholly-owned subsidiary of the University of Liverpool
- Mission-focused but unsubsidised, with the freedom to make decisions
- ▶ 7 books to 170 books, 3 journals to 50 journals
- ▶ (Re) Built on active learning and experimentation







- ▶ Round 1 (2022-2024)
 - Conditional collective subscription model, libraries purchase backlist ebook collection and frontlist is made available OA
 - ► At series level only 10 books @£8500 each funded over 3 years
 - ▶ Books published under a CC-BY-NC-ND licence
- Round 2 (2025 onwards)
 - ▶ No backlist collection, simply a request to renew/support
 - ► Argument based on strategic importance of subject (languages)



- ► Should we scale up or scale back?
- ▶ Will libraries renew without a purchase?

- ▶ Will new libraries join now that the model is established?
